### **Nottingham-based recruitment agency Frontline has become only the second agency ever to score 100 per cent in the Recruitment and Employment Confederation's Audit.**

Frontline, with offices across the East Midlands and Yorkshire, scored top marks on every aspect of industry compliance and ethical conduct after undergoing a rigorous independent assessment in all areas of its business.

The audit scheme - run by the REC, the trade association for the UK's £24.9 billion recruitment industry - is the most comprehensive audit of its kind, offering official endorsement to those recruitment agencies that run their businesses lawfully and ethically.

And to celebrate Frontline's achievement, Marcia Roberts, Chief Executive Officer of the REC, visited the agency's head office in Friar Lane, Nottingham to present Frontline staff with their Audit certificate.
